Summer Series Show Fees

• Class Entry - \$30 per class, except:

- Beginner Rider \$15
- · Short Stirrup \$20
- · Para Reining \$20
- Ranch Riding \$20
- · Walk-Trot \$0

· Paid Warm-up - \$25 per 5-minute slot (1 slot per horse unless slots are left unsold)

· Judges Fee - \$10 per run (concurrent classes pay only one judges fee)

• Office Fee - \$5 per horse per day of show

• Environmental Fee - \$5 per horse

• Stall Fees - \$80 per weekend or \$40 per night. (Stalls must be cleaned before leaving or have cleaning arranged.)

- Tack Stall fees \$60 per weekend or \$30 per night.
- Haul-in Fee \$30 per horse per day. (Applicable only if a stall has not been purchased for the horse.)

· Camping Spots - All camping spots must be pre-booked a minimum of 1 week prior to the show.

· Serviced Camping fee @ \$40/night.

· Limited Electrical only sites fee @\$30/night.

Summer Series Shows Rules

- · Rider and owner of the horse must be SRHA members.
- · Any person mounting a horse at an SRHA show must be an SRHA member.
- Horse must be owned by rider or family member or a valid SRHA or NRHA lease agreement must be supplied, except where specified by class rules.
- · Class payouts are jackpotted. SRHA retains 50% of entry fees.
- LTE refers to lifetime earnings accumulated from any type of reining class or show, including but not limited to SRHA, NRHA, and Open shows, unless stated otherwise.
- · SRHA and NRHA classes follow NRHA rules and patterns, except where SRHA rules are specified.
- Ranch reining class will run a relaxed NRHA pattern with optional lead change. Either a simple or flying lead change can be made at the center. See NRHA Green Reiner rule for relaxed patterns.
- 1st Time Reiner class will run Modified Pattern #13. The modified pattern 13 includes 4 spins in both directions and 2 stops but no lead changes. (The figure 8 is deleted.)
- · Riders in Walk-Trot class may ride on, or off, of a leadline. Riders must be SRHA Youth members.
- Horses shown by Non Pro riders must be owned by the rider or family or have a valid lease agreement, except for Walk-Trot, Short Stirrup and Ranch Reiner.
- All riders 18 years of age or under are required to wear an approved ASTM/SEI helmet when participating in any event sanctioned by the SRHA.

Summer Series Class Eligibility

- Ranch Reiner Non Pro rider with less than \$250 LTE; any horse, 1 or 2 hands, any legal bit.
- · Novice 1000 Non Pro rider with less than \$1000 LTE in Reining; any horse; 1-handed, any legal bit.
- Novice 2500 Non Pro rider with less than \$2500 LTE in Reining; any horse; 1-handed, any legal bit.
- Novice 5000 Non Pro rider with less than \$5000 LTE in Reining; any horse; 1-handed, any legal bit.
- Beginner Horse Open Any rider; horse with less than \$500 in Reining LTE; 1 or 2 hands, any legal bit.
- Beginner Horse Non Pro Non Pro rider; horse with less than \$500 in Reining LTE; horse must be owned by rider/family; 1 or 2 hands, any legal bit.
- Non Pro 3 & 4 year old Non Pro rider; horse must be 3 or 4 years old and owned by rider/family; 1 or 2 hands, any legal bit.
- Non Pro Non Pro rider; horse owned by rider/family; 1-handed, any legal bit.
- Intermediate Non-Pro Non Pro rider; horse owned by rider/family; Follows NRHA Intermediate Non Pro Eligibility, currently <\$7500 in earnings in categories 1, 2, 4, 6, 8, 11 the previous year; 1-handed, any legal bit.
- Prime Time Non Pro Non Pro rider 50 years of age or older as of January 1st of the current year; 1-handed, any legal bit.
- · Open Any rider; any horse; 1 handed, any legal bit.
- Walk-Trot Rider must be an SRHA Youth member and may ride on or off a leadline; any horse; 1 and/or 2 hands, any legal bit.
- Short Stirrup Rider must be 10 years of age or younger as of January 1st of the current year; any horse; split or closed reins; 1 and/or 2 hands, any legal bit.
- Youth 13 & under Rider must be 13 years of age or younger as of January 1st of the current year; horse must be owned by rider/family; 1 or 2 hands, any legal bit.
- Youth 14-18 Rider must be 14-18 years of age as of January 1st of the current year; 1-handed, any legal bit.
- **Beginner Rider** New members who have <\$50 in Reining earnings as of January 1st of the current year; any horse; 1 or 2 hands, any legal bit.
- World Para Reining Open to anyone with a physical disability according to WPR (World Para Reining) grade requirements. Patterns and aids may be decided at the show.
- Youth Ranch Riding Rider must be 18 years of age or younger as of January 1st of the current year; horse must be owned by rider/family. Follows AQHA patterns and rules.
- · Non Pro Ranch Riding Non Pro rider; horse owned by rider/family. Follows AQHA patterns and rules.
- · Open Ranch Riding Any rider; any horse. Follows AQHA patterns and rules.

Ranch Riding will follow SHW305 WESTERN EQUIPMENT for junior (5 and under as of January 1st of the current year) and senior horses regarding bits and 1 or 2 hands.
